### COMMITTEE MEETINGS UPDATE

Three out of the four Officers of the Society, plus Rufus Barnes who is the Chair of the 2020 sub committee met on Wednesday 13th May by Zoom Conferencing to discuss a range of issues. The outcome of those discussions has already been emailed to the full committee; of those who have responded, which is the majority, all have been in agreement with the decisions which have been made.

It is planned to have a further full committee meeting, again by way of Zoom Conferencing, on Wednesday 3rd June 2020.

### ACTIONS FROM RECENT CONFERENCE MEETING RATIFIED BY COMMITTEE

#### General;

- (i) The cancellation of the society evening meetings through to the end of August 2020
- (ii) Assuming that meetings can take place in the evenings from September to December 2020 that these will all be member type evenings and unlikely to include any visiting speakers.
- (iii) Member subscriptions are renewed as normal from 1st September 2020
- (iv) Bring forward the two annual competitions to September and October this year, but give members the opportunity to submit photocopies, either by email or mail to the secretary and in turn pdf files produced to enable remote judging by external judges ahead of the Special November dinner.
- (v) The Annual General meeting, due to be held at 7.30 pm on Friday 19th June 2020 actually takes place then by way of a Zoom remote conference. Please see comments below.



- (vi) Consideration be given to a new page on the society website, or separate link thereto, to have member short displays made available just to the members
- (vii) All committee members be invited to take part in Zoom conference committee meeting say at 11.00 am on Wednesday 3rd June 2020

#### **2020 Celebrations;**

- (i) Proceed as if everything will take place as arranged
- (ii) Fall back position to postpone dinner to say June 2021 if Covid situation prevents November dinner from being held.

#### **Annual General Meeting**

- (i) All committee members please confirm to secretary that they are willing to stand again for another year.
- (ii) Names(s) of any member who is willing to stand on the committee, not currently an elected committee member
- (iii) All curators please submit an email report to the secretary and also confirm they are willing to continue for another year.
- (iv) Details of any issue any committee member wishes to raise at the AGM, not already on the standard AGM agenda.

#### **IMMEDIATE FUTURE MEETINGS; CORONAVIRUS: COVID -19**

Members are already aware that due to the impact of COVID-19, and given the background information issued by both the government and the health authorities in mid March we did postpone the 20th March 2020 meeting and either postponed or cancelled all meetings through to the end of May 2020.

The decision has now been taken to either cancel or postpone evening society meeting for the months of June, July and August 2020.

#### **MEETINGS; September 2020 through to end January 2021**

As already indicated all meetings for the months of September 2020 through to the end of January 2021 will be member type evenings thus not involving any outside visiting speakers.

## COMPETITION EVENINGS

The closing date for the competition evening which is usually held on the first Wednesday in November will in fact be **Friday 18th September 2020**. Entries for this date will include; Postal History, Great Britain, Cinderella, First Timers and Open Class.

**Please note;** entries are to be submitted by way of attachments to an email to the CPS email address (see end of newsletter), posted to or placed through letterbox of secretary, or handed in on the evenings of either 3rd or 18th September 2020 at Oddfellows Hall.

The closing date for the competition evening which is usually held on the third Friday in February will in fact be **Friday 16th October 2020**. Entries for this date will include; 35 Year Trophy, Transportation of Mail, Thematics, Foreign, Commonwealth and 16 sheet competition on any subject listed within the rules.

**Please note;** entries are to be submitted by way of attachments to an email to the CPS email address (see end of newsletter), posted to or placed through letterbox of secretary, or handed in on the evenings of either 18th September, 7th October or 16th October 2020 at Oddfellows Hall.

All competition entries will be submitted within 48 hours of each of the deadline dates by email to an agreed judge(s) and be marked remotely.

In the event that meetings cannot be held in Oddfellows Hall during either September or October then the competitions **WILL** still take place.

It is hoped that winners will be announced at the Centenary Dinner on Friday 6th November 2020, when ideally all entries will be on display.
